

13 14 15	Amend the bill in section 18 in subsection 10 in paragraph A in the first line (page 4, line 42 in L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>deposition</u> " and inserting the following: ' <u>disposition</u> '
16 17	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
18	SUMMARY
19 20 21 22 23	This amendment makes 2 corrections to the bill. It clarifies that the definition of "contingent offer of employment" in the Maine Background Check Center Act requires an initial background check report and not a final one. It also corrects an error in the bill relating to background check report content by replacing the word "deposition" with "disposition."
