The amendment adds to the list of stakeholders the department may 10 invite to participate in the study no more than 2 representatives from the department, one 11 of whom may be a member who represents the Maine State Ferry Service, rather than a 12 representative of the department who is not involved with the Maine State Ferry Service. 13 14 The amendment specifies that stakeholders that may be invited to participate are appointed by the Commissioner of Transportation.
