## An Act Requiring Ferries to Dock Overnight on Certain Islands for Emergency Purposes

- 2 Sec. 1. 23 MRSA §4408 is enacted to read:
- 3 <u>§4408. Ferries for emergency use</u>

To support the use of ferries for emergency medical, fire and law enforcement needs,
including mass evacuation, the Department of Transportation shall require the Maine State
Ferry Service to nightly dock a ferry vessel that carries vehicles overnight in the towns of
Swan's Island, Vinalhaven, North Haven and Islesboro.
