1 Sec. 1. Department of Economic and Community Development to study 2 impact fees. **Resolved:** That the Department of Economic and Community Development, in collaboration with the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future, shall 3 convene a working group to study the process by which municipalities impose impact fees 4 under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4354. The working group must 5 6 include representatives of municipalities and developers associated with municipal 7 infrastructure improvements and others with relevant experience. The study must include 8 a review of the existing process by which municipalities establish and impose impact fees, 9 guidance related to impact fees provided to developers and documentation municipalities 10 use in establishing impact fees. For the purposes of this section, "impact fee" has the same meaning as in Title 30-A, section 4301, subsection 6-A. By December 3, 2025, the 11 department shall submit a report based on the study, including recommendations and any 12 suggested legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and Economic 13 14 Development, and the committee may report out legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature. 15

SUMMARY

17 This resolve requires the Department of Economic and Community Development, in 18 collaboration with the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future, to convene a working 19 group to study the process by which municipalities impose impact fees under the Maine 20 Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, section 4354. The working group must include 21 representatives of municipalities and developers associated with municipal infrastructure 22 improvements and others with relevant experience. The department must submit a report 23 based on the study, including recommendations and any suggested legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Housing and Economic Development, and the committee may 24 25 report out legislation related to the report to the Second Regular Session of the 132nd 26 Legislature.

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
