11	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
12	'An Act to Ban the Sale of Cell-cultured Meat'
13 14	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:
15	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §2163-A is enacted to read:
16	§2163-A. Sale of cell-cultured meat prohibited
17 18 19 20 21 22	1. Prohibition. A person within the State may not transport, receive for transportation, sell or offer for sale or distribution any cell-cultured meat or products containing cell- cultured meat or serve, expose or offer for sale or distribution, either in any public place or elsewhere, any cell-cultured meat or products containing cell-cultured meat. For purposes of this section, "cell-cultured meat" means any meat or food product produced from cultured animal cells.
23 24	2. Inspection. The commissioner shall by adequate inspection see that the requirements of this section are carried out.
25 26 27 28	3. Penalties. A person that violates any provision of this section commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$100 for the first offense and a fine of not more than \$200 for each subsequent offense must be adjudged. The District Court and Superior Court have concurrent jurisdiction of the offense.'
29 30	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
31	SUMMARY
32 33	This amendment bans the sale or distribution of cell-cultured meat. The amendment defines cell-cultured meat as any meat or food product produced from cultured animal cells.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 832, L.D. 1257

The amendment provides that a person who violates the ban on the sale or distribution of cell-cultured meat commits a civil violation for which a fine of not more than \$100 for the first offense and a fine of not more than \$200 for each subsequent offense must be adjudged.
