1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1605, sub-§1, ¶C**, as amended by PL 2023, c. 395, Pt. A,
3 §1, is further amended to read:

4 C. Be in the amount or limit of at least:

5 (1) For damage to property, \$25,000;

6 (2) For injury to or death of any one person, \$50,000;

7 (3) For one accident resulting in injury to or death of more than one person,
8 \$100,000;

9 (4) For medical payments pursuant to section 1605-A, \$2,000; ~~and~~

10 (5) For towing and storage charges pursuant to section 1605-B, \$500-; and

11 (6) For intrastate commercial motor vehicles, a combined single limit of \$750,000.

12 **SUMMARY**

13 This bill establishes a minimum insurance requirement for intrastate commercial motor
14 vehicles of \$750,000 to bring state requirements in line with federal financial responsibility
15 requirements.
