COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 510, L.D. 1282, "An Act Regarding Eligibility for Historic Preservation Bond Proceeds"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subparagraph (2) in the last line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "ordinance" the following: 'or comprehensive plan as defined in Title 30-A, section 4301, subsection 3'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "ordinances" the following: 'or comprehensive plans as defined in Title 30-A, section 4301, subsection 3'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following:

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 510, L.D. 1282 (S-96)

SUMMARY

This amendment adds to the bill historic properties designated by comprehensive plans to the eligibility requirements for grants for the preservation and restoration of historic properties through the Maine Historic Preservation Commission. The amendment also requires the Maine Historic Preservation Commission to include historic properties that have been designated as historic properties by comprehensive plans in receiving funding through bond proceeds authorized by Public Law 2023, chapter 653.
