STATE OF MAINE SENATE 132ND LEGISLATURE FIRST SPECIAL SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 520, L.D. 1290, "An Act to Update the Laws Regarding Athletic Trainers"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §14352, sub-§4-A is enacted to read:

4-A. Board of Certification for the Athletic Trainer. "Board of Certification for the Athletic Trainer" means the national credentialing organization for the entry-level athletic training profession or its successor organization approved by the department."

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the last line (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or successor organization"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in paragraph E in the first 2 lines (page 1, lines 30 and 31 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or successor organization"

Amend the bill in section 4 in the indented paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 37 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "or successor organization"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds a definition of "Board of Certification for the Athletic Trainer" to the bill.
