COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 541, L.D. 1311 (S.278)

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the Maine Health Care Education Training and Medical Residency Fund may be used for clinical preceptorships and clinical rotations for all health profession students in rural and underserved communities. It also provides that the fund may be used to expand rural residency positions and rotations for medical school graduates in the State, instead of medical students as in the bill. It reduces the funding required for the fund from \$5,000,000 to \$1,950,000 per fiscal year.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes ongoing annual General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,950,000 beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 to support health care in rural and underserved communities and physician workforce development.
