A license must state, at a minimum, the name, date of birth, place of residence or mailing address if different from the residence, of the licensee and the permanent number assigned to that licensee. A license also must state whether the licensee is a citizen of the United States, a noncitizen of the United States or an asylum seeker. A name displayed on a license must be as the name appears on a birth certificate or a court order or as the result of marriage.
