COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 867, L.D. 1332, "An Act to Establish the Community Schools Success Fund to Ensure the Implementation and Success of Community Schools Programs"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §9924 in subsection 2 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 20 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "9922" the following: 'must be a school administrative unit that has begun developing a community school plan pursuant to section 9922, subsection 1 for a school not yet designated as a community school'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Community Schools Success Fund N554

Initiative: Provides base allocations to authorize expenditures of funds received to provide grants to community schools, local education providers and nonprofit organizations.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds base allocations of \$500 per year beginning in fiscal year 2025-26 for a new created Community Schools Success Fund within the Department of Education to authorize expenditures in the event the funds are received to provide grants to community schools, local education providers and nonprofit organizations to support community schools programs. No funding is provided in the bill. The Department of Education has indicated that it will require a part-time contracted position to oversee the grant program once funding is received at an estimated cost of \$40,000 per year.
