Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1304-B, sub-§8 is enacted to read:

8. Contract to operate Juniper Ridge Landfill. The department may not enter into or renew a contract for the operation of the state-owned Juniper Ridge Landfill, located in the City of Old Town, without the approval of the Legislature.

Approval of a contract under this subsection does not replace any other license required by law.

SUMMARY

This bill requires the approval of the Legislature for a contract or a contract renewal for the operation of the state-owned Juniper Ridge Landfill, located in the City of Old Town.
