Resolved: That, by December 3, 16 17 2025, the Department of Transportation shall submit to the Joint Standing Committee on 18 Transportation a report detailing the department's progress on implementing the 19 recommendations from the 2025 Public Transit Advisory Council report pursuant to the 20 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 23, section 4209-A, subsection 5. The report must include, 21 but is not limited to, a summary of actions taken toward implementing each 22 recommendation to the department from the Public Transit Advisory Council report, 23 including specific dates on which those actions were taken; a list of specific dates on which 24 the department plans to take additional actions toward implementing each 25 recommendation; and a list of recommendations not yet implemented. The Joint Standing 26 Committee on Transportation may report out legislation to the Second Regular Session of 27 the 132nd Legislature based on the report.' 28 Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 29 section number to read consecutively. 30 SUMMARY 31 This amendment replaces the resolve and changes the title. The amendment requires the Department of Transportation, by December 3, 2025, to submit to the Joint Standing 32 33 Committee on Transportation a report detailing its progress on implementing the 34 recommendations from the 2025 Public Transit Advisory Council report, including specific 35 dates of actions taken toward implementing those recommendations and specific dates on
