Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §33, as enacted by PL 1993, c. 473, §2 and affected by §46, is amended to read:

§33. Prosecution Investigation and prosecution of violations

The Secretary of State shall designate sworn law enforcement officers employed by the Department of the Secretary of State to investigate alleged violations of the election laws. The Attorney General shall designate a Deputy Attorney General or an Assistant Attorney General to investigate assist in the investigation of and to prosecute alleged violations of the election laws. This section does not preclude a district attorney from investigating and prosecuting election law violations.

11 SUMMARY

This bill requires the Secretary of State to designate sworn law enforcement officers employed by the Department of the Secretary of State to investigate alleged violations of the election laws. It also changes the current law to require the Attorney General to designate a Deputy Attorney General or an Assistant Attorney General to assist in the investigation.
