9 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 940, L.D. 1431, "An Act to Implement an Interstate Voter Registration Cross-check Program"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to End Information Sharing of Voter Registration Information Through a Contract with a Nonprofit Corporation of Member States'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

- 'Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §161, sub-§2-B, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 398, Pt. UUUU, §1 and affected by §7, is repealed.
- Sec. 2. Terminate membership agreement with Electronic Registration Information Center, Inc. By January 1, 2026, the Secretary of State shall, on behalf of the State, terminate the State's membership agreement with the Electronic Registration Information Center, Inc. that was entered into pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 161, subsection 2-B.
- Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

Sec. 4. Effective date. That section of this Act that repeals the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 161, subsection 2-B takes effect January 1, 2026.'

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SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. The amendment repeals, on January 1, 2026, the provision of law requiring the Secretary of State to contract with a nonprofit corporation of member states for periodic sharing of voter registration information, including information on names and addresses of voters in member states, and directing the Secretary of State to periodically update the central voter registration system based on the information obtained. The amendment also directs the Secretary of State to terminate the State's membership agreement with the Electronic Registration Information Center, Inc. by January 1, 2026.
