Hospital safe sleep rule for infants; parental behavior 15 A hospital licensed pursuant to chapter 405 that has a safe sleep rule for infants shall inform the parent or guardian of an infant who is an inpatient at the hospital of the safe 16 17 sleep rule for infants, and the parent or guardian shall sign a form provided by the hospital 18 that contains the text of the safe sleep rule for infants acknowledging that the parent or 19 guardian knows the safe sleep rule for infants. If the parent or guardian refuses to sign the 20 form, the hospital shall document the refusal in the medical record prior to discharge from 21 the hospital. For purposes of this section, "safe sleep rule for infants" means a set of 22 evidence-based practices a hospital requires to be employed in order to reduce the rate of infants' unsafe sleep injuries and sudden unexpected infant death related to unsafe sleep, 23 24 including accidental suffocation and strangulation in bed and sudden infant death 25 syndrome.' Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 26 27 number to read consecutively. **SUMMARY** 28 29 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, makes the following 30 changes to the bill. 1. It clarifies that the safe sleep rule relates to infants rather than children. 31 32 2. It clarifies that a guardian, in addition to a parent, may be the person responsible for 33 the infant.
