Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A-2 in subparagraph (1) in the last line (page
1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "and"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A-2 in subparagraph (2) in the last line (page
1, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "(1)." and inserting the following: '(1);
and'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph A-2 by inserting after subparagraph (2) the
following:

'(3) The state of emergency described in subparagraph (1) lasts 5 days or fewer.

A school board requesting to waive or reduce the minimum number of days
required under this subsection as a result of a state of emergency lasting more than
5 days shall submit an application pursuant to paragraph A.'

Amend the bill in section 2 in the last line (page 1, line 18 in L.D.) by inserting after
the following: "A-2" the following: 'as a result of a declared state of emergency lasting 5
days or fewer'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
number to read consecutively.

This amendment provides that the commissioner must reduce or waive the minimum
number of instructional days on request of a school board when the school is located in a
section of the State for which a state of emergency lasting 5 days or fewer has been
