The holes must be marked either by evergreen 19 boughs placed around the hole or by suspending at least one strand of fluorescent 20 biodegradable tape at least 3 feet above the ice around the entire perimeter of the 21 hole so that the tape is visible from all sides; 22 Sec. 2. 12 MRSA §12551-A, sub-§6, ¶B, as amended by PL 2023, c. 431, §§18 23 and 19 and affected by §23, is further amended by amending subparagraph (4) to read: 24 (4) Take eels; or 25 **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §12551-A, sub-§6, ¶B,** as amended by PL 2023, c. 431, §§18 and 19 and affected by §23, is further amended by repealing subparagraph (5). 26 27 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 28 number to read consecutively. 29 **SUMMARY** 30 This amendment replaces the bill. It amends the authorizations and restrictions 31 applying to baitfish wholesaler's licenses. The amendment removes the restriction that 32 prohibits a license holder from taking or selling suckers, Genus Catostomus, greater than 33 10 inches in length between April 1st and September 30th of each year. Finally, the
