A separate nonlapsing, interest-bearing account, administered by the department, is established in the department within the Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to support public-private partnerships to carry out the purposes of the program. The account consists of money appropriated or allocated to it by the Legislature or received from any private or public source.

Transfer.</b> Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, on or before June 30, 2026, the State Controller shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Bureau of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources, Maine Working Farmland Access and Protection Program established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 7, section 164 for funding to support farmland conservation efforts.
