COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 626, L.D. 1542, "An Act to Amend the Membership of the Washington County Budget Advisory Committee"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §900-B by striking out all of subsection 2-A (page 1, lines 42 to 44 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

'2-A. Member from unorganized territory. The county commissioners shall select, by majority vote, one member who is a resident of the unorganized territory in Washington County who has not served in or been employed by Washington County government within the past 3 years and is not a current employee of Washington County government as a voting member of the budget advisory committee to serve a 3-year term.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill by specifying that the county commissioners must select, by majority vote, one member who is a resident of the unorganized territory in Washington County who has not served in or been employed by Washington County government within the past 3 years and is not a current employee of Washington County government as a voting member of the budget advisory committee to serve a 3-year term.
