COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 634, L.D. 1550, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services to Amend Its Rules to Protect Water Quality by Reducing Nutrient Pollution from Septic Systems"

Amend the resolve in section 3 in the 4th to 6th lines (page 1, lines 36 to 38 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", solicit public comment on the draft rules for a period of at least 30 days and hold a public hearing on the draft rules in the same manner as a public hearing must be conducted under" and inserting the following: 'and shall hold a public hearing on the draft rules in accordance with the process described in'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
