1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 2 MRSA §2, as amended by PL 2023, c. 488, §2, is further amended to read:
3	§2. Expense account
4 5 6 7 8 9	The "Governor's Expense Account" expense account must be credited with \$40,000 \$30,000 annually. This appropriation must be available for expenditure by the Governor at the Governor's discretion. This account is not subject to audit, except as to total amount to be paid. The Governor, on a quarterly basis, shall provide an accounting of expenses made from the Governor's expense account and post that accounting on the Governor's publicly accessible website.

11 12 13	This bill reduces the annual appropriation to the Governor's expense account to \$30,000 and requires the Governor to provide a quarterly accounting of expenses made from the account and post that accounting on the Governor's publicly accessible website.
