The department shall communicate this information to 22 industry members, and the committee may report out a bill based on the report to the 23 Second Regular Session of the 132nd Legislature. 24 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 25 number to read consecutively. SUMMARY 26 27 This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve. The amendment directs the 28 Department of Marine Resources to submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on 29 Marine Resources no later than January 1, 2026 with findings and recommendations of the 30 Aquaculture Advisory Council and the council's subcommittees. The focus of the report

must be the council's findings and recommendations related to deliberations concerning
