1 2 3 4	Amend the bill in section 1 in §2532 in the indented paragraph in the 5th line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "an automatic recount is required" and inserting the following: 'a recount may be conducted upon the majority vote of the municipal officers'
5	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 0	This amendment amends the bill by removing the requirement that an automatic recount must be conducted when a municipal referendum passes or fails by less than 1% and instead providing that such a recount may be conducted upon the majority vote of the municipal officers.
