HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 656,
L.D. 1648, "Resolve, to Honor Margaret Chase Smith and Joshua Chamberlain in the
National Statuary Hall"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title the following:


'Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 10th line (page 1, line 10 in L.D.) by inserting
after the following: "shall" the following: 'begin to' '

Amend the amendment in the 2nd instructional paragraph in the last line (page 1, line
20 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "House." the following: 'The
commissions are authorized to contract with one or more entities to complete their duties
under this section.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment authorizes the Maine Arts Commission, the Maine State Museum
Commission and the Maine Historic Preservation Commission to contract with one or more
entities to complete the statue replacement and relocation under the resolve. The
amendment also clarifies that the statue replacement may take longer than one year.
