15 16 17	Amend the bill in section 7 in §287 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 4, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "victims" and inserting the following: 'victims a victim of the alleged crime'
18 19	Amend the bill in section 7 in §287 in subsection 2-A in the 3rd line (page 4, line 38 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "victim" the following: 'of the alleged crime'
20 21	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
22	SUMMARY
23 24	This amendment makes a technical change to the bill to clarify that the evidence collected during a forensic examination relates to an alleged sexual assault crime.
