SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment requires that student-to-teacher ratios for a career and technical education center or region with fewer than 1,000 students enrolled within the center's or region's geographic boundaries must provide for at least one full-time equivalent teacher allocation for programs with a minimum of 4 students. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.
