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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 716, L.D. 1834 (S.239)

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and changes the title. Under current law, a carrier must provide a health care provider a method for making claims payments using an electronic funds transfer through the automated clearinghouse network. The amendment provides that, for the purposes of that requirement, a health care provider includes a person licensed to provide dental services under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, chapter 143, subchapter 3 and a carrier includes an insurer that provides dental insurance.
