HOUSE AMENDMENT " C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1231, L.D. 1847, "An Act to Institute Testing and Tracking of Medical Use Cannabis and Cannabis Products Similar to Adult Use Cannabis and Cannabis Products, Dedicate a Portion of the Adult Use Cannabis Sales and Excise Tax to Medical Use Cannabis Programs and Create a Study Group"

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 7 in subsection 45-A in the 4th line (page 2, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "the application of heat, radiation or ozone:"


Amend the amendment in Part A in section 7 in subsection 45-A in the 4th line (page 2, line 27 in amendment) by striking out the following: "or" and inserting the following: 'the application of heat or'

Amend the amendment in Part A in section 30 in §2430-P in subsection 1 in the last line (page 12, line 11 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "testing." the following: 'Radiation or ozone may not be used to remediate cannabis flower or cannabis products.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment prohibits the use of radiation or ozone to remediate cannabis flower or cannabis products.
