1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §14212-A, sub-§2, ¶B-1 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6 7	B-1. Requirements that educational programs for aestheticians, barber hair stylists, cosmetologists and hair designers include training on the care, styling and treatment of textured hair. For the purposes of this paragraph, "textured hair" means hair that is coiled, curly or wavy. At a minimum, the rules must require those educational programs to provide training in:
8 9	(1) Techniques for the cutting and styling of and using chemical treatments for textured hair;
10	(2) The use of products and tools specifically designed for textured hair;
11 12	(3) Best practices for hair health and scalp care for individuals with textured hair; and
13	(4) The cultural and historical significance of textured hair in diverse communities;

15 16 17	This bill requires the Director of the Office of Professional and Occupational Regulation within the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation to adopt rules that require educational programs for aestheticians, barber hair stylists, cosmetologists and
18	hair designers to include training on the care, styling and treatment of coiled, curly or wavy

19 hair, which is defined in the bill as "textured hair."
