SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 749,
L.D. 1908, "An Act to Require the Cooperation of Original Manufacturers of Electronic
Devices to Facilitate the Repair of Those Devices by Device Owners and Independent
Repair Providers"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in c. 247 in §1500-QQ in subsection 5 in the last
line (page 7, line 21 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "Act." the following:
'Notwithstanding Title 5, section 213, an independent repair provider or owner may not
bring an action in Superior Court or District Court for a violation of this section.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that an independent repair provider or an owner of digital
electronic equipment may not bring an action in Superior Court or District Court for a
violation of the laws governing the right to repair electronic equipment.
