COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1281, L.D. 1920, "An Act to Prohibit the Sale of Potentially Intoxicating Hemp Products to a Person Under 21 Years of Age"

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 13 in paragraph A in the first line (page 2, line 29 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "a" the following: 'beverage.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

**SUMMARY**

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, adds beverages to the list of potentially intoxicating hemp products that are not required to be packaged in child-resistant and tamper-evident packaging.
