Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and 3 Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and 4 5 Whereas, this legislation affects certain obligations and expenses during the course of the current fiscal year; and 6 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as 8 immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 9 10 therefore, 11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: PART A 12 13 Sec.
