Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

12 'An Act to Exempt Pesticides from the Law Regulating Perfluoroalkyl and
 13 Polyfluoroalkyl Substances in Products'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

16 'Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §606, sub-§1, ¶G, as amended by PL 2021, c. 673, §4, is further
 amended to read:

18 G. Beginning January 1, 2022, a pesticide containing chlorpyrifos as an active
 19 ingredient; or

 Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §606, sub-§1, ¶H, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 673, §4, is amended

 to read:

H. A pesticide that has been contaminated by perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances; or.

24 Sec. 3. 7 MRSA §606, sub-§1, ¶I, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 673, §4, is repealed.

25 Sec. 4. 38 MRSA §1614, sub-§4, ¶D-1 is enacted to read:

26D-1. A pesticide, as defined in Title 7, section 604, subsection 25, regulated under27Title 7, chapter 103, subchapter 2-A;'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section
 number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill and changes the title. It amends the law regulating perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl

substances in products to exempt from the requirements of that law pesticides regulated under the Maine Pesticide Control Act of 1975. The amendment also amends the Maine Pesticide Control Act of 1975 to remove a corresponding prohibition on the distribution in the State of pesticides that are prohibited from sale or distribution in the State pursuant to the law regulating perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances in products.
