COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 808, L.D. 1995, "An Act to Require the Maine Office of Community Affairs to Establish a Technical Assistance Materials Hub"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §3209 in subsection 2 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 9 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "hub" the following: 'on the publicly accessible website maintained by the office'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, clarifies that the technical assistance materials hub required by the bill must be established and maintained on the publicly accessible website of the Maine Office of Community Affairs.
