COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 851, L.D. 2063, "An Act to Clarify Activities Allowed Under the Natural Resources Protection Act"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 36 in paragraph C in the last line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: ", and" and inserting the following: ";

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 36 by inserting after paragraph C the following:

'As used in this subsection, "native dune vegetation" has the same meaning as in section 480-E, subsection 15; and'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, incorporates a cross-reference to a definition for the term "native dune vegetation."
