COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 851, L.D. 2063, "An Act to Clarify Activities Allowed Under the Natural Resources Protection Act"

Amend the bill in section 8 in paragraph F in the first line (page 2, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "brooks;" the following: 'and'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 9 and 10 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 9. 38 MRSA §480-Z, sub-§7, ¶G is enacted to read:

G. Habitat for state endangered and state threatened species that is significant wildlife habitat as defined in section 480-B, subsection 10, paragraph B, subparagraph (4).'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, removes from the bill the addition of great ponds to the list of areas under the Department of Environmental Protection's compensation program in the Natural Resources Protection Act.
