Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of the emergency preamble.'


Amend the amendment in the first instructional paragraph in the first and 2nd lines
(page 1, lines 11 and 12 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and before the
emergency clause"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of sections 2 and 3.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to remove the emergency
preamble and emergency clause from the bill. It also removes from Committee Amendment
"A" the section that amends the requirements for the written notice of a parking violation
and the appropriations and allocations section.
