SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to S.P. 899, L.D. 2211, "An Act Implementing the Recommendations of the Automotive Right to Repair Working Group"

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 2-A in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "12" and inserting the following: '13'

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 2-A in paragraph A in subparagraph (6) in the first line (page 1, line 39 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "One member" and inserting the following: 'Two members'

Amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 2-A in paragraph A by inserting after subparagraph (8) the following:

'Except for the members appointed pursuant to subparagraph (1), all members must be residents of the State.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds another member representing new motor vehicle dealers in the State to the membership of the Motor Vehicle Right to Repair Commission and requires that all members, except the 3 members representing motor vehicle manufacturers, be residents of Maine.
