SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1507, L.D. 2232, "An Act to Increase County Jail Funding"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. Credit of funds for county jails for jail operations costs. Notwithstanding the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, section 1532, in fiscal year 2025-26, prior to the credit of any investment earnings on the Maine Budget Stabilization Fund, the State Controller shall first credit \$4,000,000 of investment earnings to the County Jail Operations Fund, Other Special Revenue Funds account in the Department of Corrections for distributions to counties for jail operations costs.

Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

CORRECTIONS, DEPARTMENT OF
County Jail Operations Fund Z227

Initiative: Provides a one-time allocation to the County Jail Operations Fund for distribution to counties for jail operations costs.

The amendment removes the fiscal year 2026-27 General Fund appropriation of \$9,657,896 and replaces it with a one-time fiscal year 2025-26 Other Special Revenue Funds allocation of \$4,000,000 for county jail operations funded by crediting up to \$4,000,000 in Maine Budget Stabilization Fund interest in fiscal year 2025-26.
