HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1512, L.D. 2236, "An Act Regarding Public Records Maintained by the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the first instance of subsection 4 the following:

'5. Exception to archive laws. Notwithstanding Title 5, section 95-C, subsection 1, paragraph C, personally identifiable information made confidential under this section must remain confidential until the relevant records have been in existence for 100 years.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to provide that personally identifiable information made confidential in the bill as amended by the committee amendment must remain confidential until the records have been in existence for 100 years.
