STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE concerning an amendment of the constitution of
Maine.

Resolved, That the following amendment to the Constitution
2 of this State be proposed for the action of the legal voters of
3 this State, in the manner required by the Constitution, to wit :

4 No. 14.

5 TAXATION.

6 Section eight of Article nine, shall be amended, by inserting
7 after the word "real" the words "and personal," so that the
8 section, as amended, shall read as follows :

9 SECTION 8. All taxes upon real and personal estate, assessed
10 by authority of this State, shall be apportioned and assessed
11 equally according to the just value thereof.

1 Said Article shall be further amended, by adding the fol-
2 lowing :

3 SECTION 9. The Legislature shall never, in any manner,
4 suspend or surrender the power of taxation.
