## STATEOF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ÓNE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section eighteenth of chapter eightyeight of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section eighteen of chapter eighty-eight 2 of the revised statutes, is hereby amended, so that it 3 shall read as follows: " an account of all the charges 4 and expenses attending the partition, shall, on request 5 of any petitioner, be presented to the court, and the 6 presiding judge shall determine, after giving notice to 7 all concerned, the equitable proportion thereof to be 8 paid by the several owners in the lands of which par9 tition has been made, and execution therefor may be 10 issued against any owner neglecting to pay."

Sect. 2. This act shall not apply to the taxation of 2 costs and payment of expenses in any petition for par3 tition now pending.

Secr. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
