## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section sixteen of chapter seventyseven of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section sixteen of chapter seventy-seven of the re-

- 2 vised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in
- 3 the second line, the words "section fourteen," and
- 4 inserting in their place the words "this chapter," so
- b that said section as amended shall read as follows:
- 6 "The clerk of a county, by virtue of a certificate
- 7 provided for in this chapter, received in vacation and
- 8 stating the day of its reception, which shall be deemed
- 9 the day of the rendition of judgment, shall enter judg-
- 10 ment as of the preceding term, and execution may
- 11 issue as of that term; but all attachments then in

- 12 force continue thirty days after the next term in that
- 13 county; and if the defendant was arrested on mesne
- 14 process and gave bond to disclose after judgment, he
- 15 may do so after said [next term without breach of his
- 16 bond."
