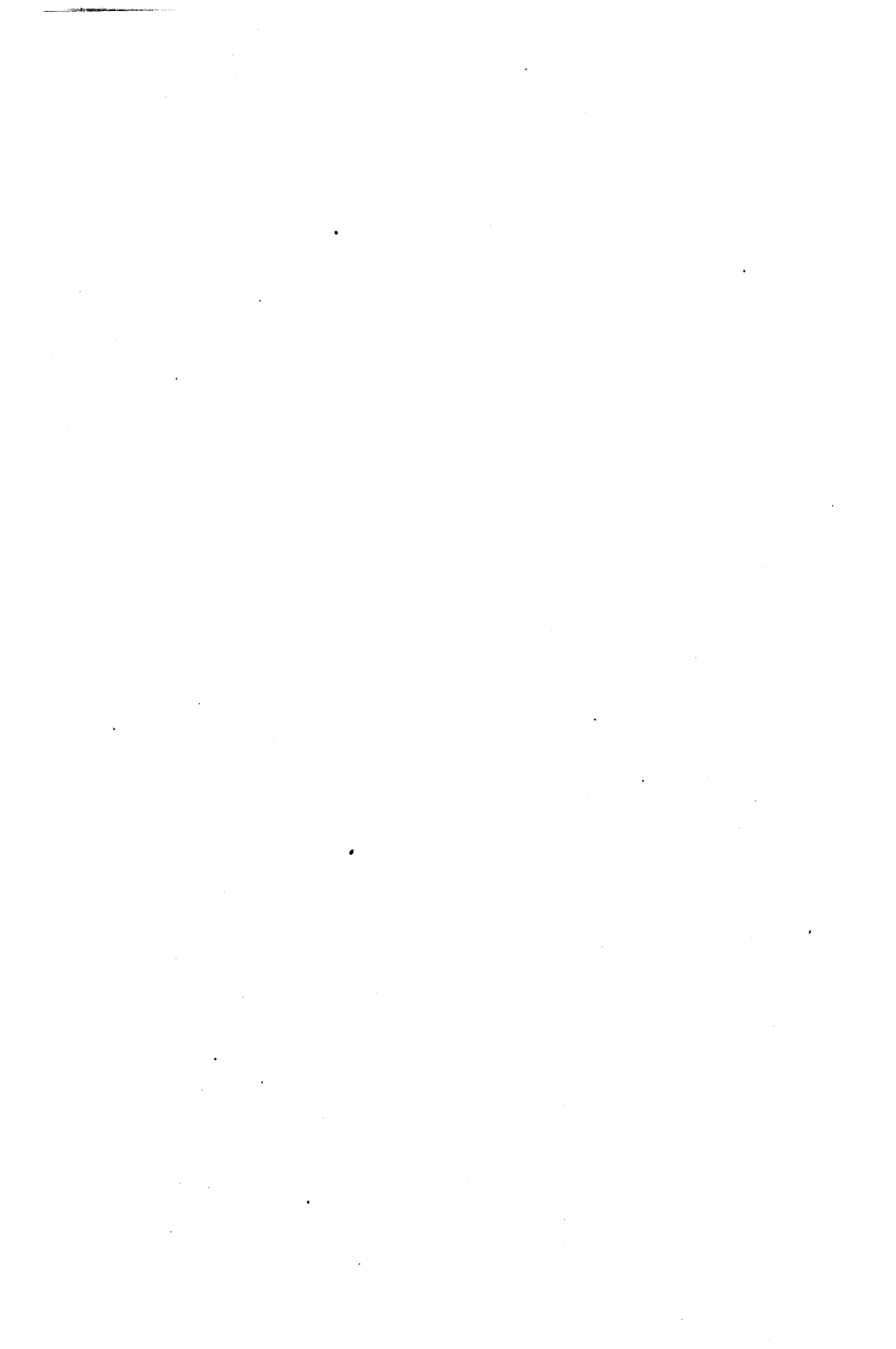
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND
SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section seven of chapter six of the
revised statutes relating to the assessment and collection
of taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section seven, chapter six of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by striking out the words, “if towns
3 so vote,” so that said section, as amended, shall read
4 as follows :

5 All dogs more than six months old shall be taxed
6 one dollar in the town where they are kept, on the first
7 day of April each year, to the owner or person who
8 has them in possession at that time.
