## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section eighty-seven of chapter eightytwo of the revised statutes, relating to witnesses and evidence, by adding a fifth exception.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Fifth. In all actions where an executor, adminis-

- 2 trator, or other legal representative is a party, and the
- 3 opposite party is an heir of the estate of the deceased,
- 4 said heir may testify when any other heir of the estate
- 5 of the deceased shall testify at the instance of such
- 6 executor, administrator, or other legal representative.
