STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in aid of building bridge over Gagnon stream in the town of Frenchville.

Resolved, That there be paid from the state treasury, 2 to the treasurer of the town of Frenchville, the sum of 3 two hundred dollars, whenever the county commis-4 sioners of Aroostook county shall certify to the state 5 treasurer that said town of Frenchville has built a 6 good and substantial bridge over Gagnon stream in 7 said town.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Frenchville, with a population of some 1,900, has a valuation of some \$80,000 only, and has at least fifty miles of road to keep in repair. Besides this, there are several bridges to be kept in repair by said town, and the one over Gagnon Stream must be built this coming season; and as it must necessarily involve an expenditure of money, it is absolutely impossible for that town, under existing circumstances, to build said bridge without some help. Said bridge must be at least seventy feet in length, and cost some four hundred dollars.
