## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend section eight, chapter sixty-four of the revised statutes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section eight of chapter sixty-four of the revised 2 statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word 3 "judge," in the fourth line, the words " on applica4 tion of parties interested," so that said section, as 5 amended, shall read as follows:
6 Sect. 8. Letters testamentary may issue, or sales 7 of real estate be made, under the provisions of a will, 8 without the executor giving bond, or by his giving one 9 in a specified sum when the will so provides; but 10 when it appears necessary or proper, the judge, on 11 application of parties interested, may require him to 12 give bond as in other cases.
