STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT additional to chapter twenty-nine of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine, concerning the militia.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

- Section 1. The volunteer company known as the
- 2 Portland Montgomery Guards, is hereby made subject
- 3 to all the duties and granted all the privileges provided
- 4 for volunteer companies of militia, by chapter twenty-
- 5 nine of the laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-nine.
 - SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
