STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND SEVENTY-SIX.

AN ACT to amend chapter fifty-one, section fifty-one, relative to railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section fifty-one of chapter fifty-one of the revised 2 statutes is amended so as to read as follows:

3 Sect. 51. They shall keep an accurate account of 4 the receipts and expenditures of such road, and exhibit 5 it on request to any officer of the corporation or other 6 person interested. They shall from the receipts keep 7 the road, buildings and equipments in repair, furnish 8 such new rolling stock as is necessary, and the balance 9 after paying running expenses shall be applied to the 10 payment of any damages arising from misfeasance in 11 the management of the road, and after that according

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12 to the rights of parties under the mortgage. They 13 shall not be personally liable except for malfeasance 14 or fraud. When all over due bonds and coupons 15 secured by the mortgage are paid they shall surrender 16 the road and other property to the parties entitled 17 thereto.
